Migration Roadmap

Step 1: Planning & Assessment

Identity and Authentication Management: Your current AD setup may use complex authentication protocols (like Kerberos or NTLM) or custom Group Policies. These might not seamlessly transfer to Azure AD, which could cause challenges with Single Sign-On (SSO) or hybrid identity synchronisation. As a result, users might face issues logging in, leading to potential downtime if not handled properly.

Data Migration Complexity: Moving mailboxes, calendars, and contacts from your legacy Exchange server to Exchange Online can be tricky, especially if you have large mailboxes, shared folders, or archived data.
